Stars Flock to Clinton Charity Birthday Bash

Leave it to **Bill Clinton** to host Hollywood's hottest party. To celebrate both the 10-year anniversary of the William J. Clinton Foundation and his 65th birthday (which was actually in August), the former president organized a sold-out concert at the Hollywood Bowl on Oct. 15 with performances by **Bono** and **The Edge**, **Usher**, and **Lady Gaga**. "Bill, I'm having my first real Marilyn moment," gushed Gaga, who channeled the icon in a blond wig just moments before taking the stage to perform her song "The Edge of Glory." Gaga also sang a revised rendition of her hit "Bad Romance," changing the lyrics to "Bill Romance." **Ashton Kutcher** and **Ellen DeGeneres** were among the presenters at the event, which featured a pretaped **Funny or Die** sketch starring **Sean Penn**, **Matt Damon**, **Kristen Wiig**, and **Kevin Spacey** (who does a mean Bubba impression), as well as a slew of celebrity attendees, including **Maria Shriver**, **Barbra Streisand**, and **Zach Galifianakis**. —CARRIE BORZILLO
